SUBJECT: Positive case of COVID-19 on campus

We have been informed that a member of the Boréal community in Sudbury has tested positive for COVID-19. This person is now in self-isolation and we wish them a full and speedy recovery.

Although this person did not access the campus's main building since contracting the virus, the individual did access the residence. Public Health Sudbury & Districts (PHSD) has already reached out to anyone who could have come into contact with this individual. Residence staff members are following Campus Living Centres' *COVID-19 Operational Guidelines and Protocols* and keeping us informed of the situation.

The campus remains open for those who must be on site for hands-on learning activities. Several measures are in place to prevent the spread of the virus within Boréal campuses and sites. These include, but are not limited to, routine cleaning protocols and frequent disinfection of high-touch surfaces, controlled and limited access to facilities, pre-screening for COVID-19 symptoms before access is granted, physical distancing measures, and the wearing of masks on site.

Let's do our part to reduce the spread of COVID-19 in our communities. If you are sick, stay home. Maintain physical distancing, wear a mask, and practise proper hand hygiene.
